

## IUPUI Libraries Citation Management Software

Citation Management Software helps keep track of your citations, retrieve the full-text articles of saved citations quickly and easily, share citations with colleagues throughout the world, and will automatically generate bibliographies. Here is an overview of programs supported at IUPUI.

	<b>Zotero</b>	<b>EndNote</b>	<b>EndNote Web</b>
<b>Learning Curve</b>	Very user-friendly and easy to learn, with a playlist-like interface.	Medium-high	Easy learning curve
<b>Integration with Microsoft Word</b>	Excellent: Zotero requires installation of a Microsoft Word plug-in, which is available at <a href="http://www.zotero.org/support/microsoft_word_integration">www.zotero.org/support/microsoft_word_integration</a> . Users can also drag and drop citations from Zotero into Microsoft Word or any other text editor.	Excellent: "Cite While You Write" feature will automatically cite sources as you type.	Excellent: "Cite While You Write" feature is very similar to the EndNote desktop version.
<b>Import Features</b>	Importing references is a one-click process and much faster than EndNote or EndNote Web. Zotero automatically "recognizes" many websites (including Flickr and YouTube), and works very well with blogs, wikis, and online newspapers.	Over 30 library databases provide direct import into EndNote. Databases that do not, require a multistep process to import references.	Only a handful of library databases provide a direct import into EndNote Web. Other databases require a multistep process to import references. Browser toolbar allows citations from webpages to be captured.
<b>Output Styles</b>	16 styles come automatically with Zotero, and many more are available for download at <a href="http://www.zotero.org/styles">www.zotero.org/styles</a> .	Over 1000 come installed; many more available for download from <a href="http://www.endnote.com">http://www.endnote.com</a> .	1,000
<b>Link to Images</b>	Yes. Zotero can also store "snapshots" of web pages. Users then have the option of using "highlighter" and "sticky notes" tools to take notes on snapshots.	Yes	Yes

<b>Store Attachments</b>	Yes	Yes	No, but can link to pdf files, and other online documents
<b>Working Collaboratively</b>	Currently, the best way to share a Zotero library is to export it and send it to someone else. Future Zotero versions will allow users to view other users' libraries (with user permission).	Use the mini-EndNote Traveling Library within a Word document. There is not an easy way to share an entire EndNote library, but it can be done via a network.	Users may share EndNote Web references with other EndNote Web users.
