

Production Instructions


1. Record your Audio script using Audacity

Record the script that you created during the "Scripting" portion of the workshop. You will record an audio file using the "Procedure for Recording Audio".


2. Open *.mp3 file

- Select an *.mp3 file from your desktop (found in the "Reel Quick Video Tech Camp", "Media for Editing" folder) - there are about 8 or so to select from
- From the Project pulldown, select Import Audio
- Find the *.mp3 file, and Open
- You should now have two files open in the Audacity window (audio & the mp3 file)

3. Move/adjust audio files


- Select the Time Shift Tool ()
- Move the audio recording to 5 or 6 seconds
- This will allow the music file to play as the Introduction

4. Fade Out music file

- Select the Selection Tool ()
- Highlight the *.mp3 file that remains after 5 seconds
- Delete the end of the *.mp3 file
- Highlight the *.mp3 file from about 2 to 5 seconds of the *.mp3 file
- Select Effect pulldown
- Select Fade Out

5. Edit audio file

It's always desirable to get the best possible sound from the start.

- Select any unwanted sounds, using the Selection Tool ()
- Highlight the area
- Select delete

6. Save your new audio/sound intro file
